



WCDS **UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS**

Updated for 2018-2019

UNIFORM GOALS, RATIONALE & RULES

Wakefield Country Day School requires all students to wear specified clothing each day. The reasons for this requirement are many:

- Uniform dress expectations support the school’s mission of character development and virtue by discouraging the superficial expression of “individuality” in lieu of positive and substantive development of each student’s unique personality.
- Research indicates that students who attend schools which require uniforms demonstrate higher levels of achievement, fewer discipline referrals, and better attendance than students who attend schools which do not require uniforms.
- Students learn appropriate dress as they prepare to enter the world of work and the adult community.
- Students visibly progress to more mature styles of dress through the uniform requirements, symbolizing their growing responsibility and leadership.
- Students are not under pressure to compete with one another regarding their clothing, eliminating a major manifestation of differences in income.
- Students may focus on learning and achievement without the distractions of variations in clothing.
- Parents understand the school community’s expectations of dress, and students see themselves as neat, well-dressed, and attractive.
- Parents may invest in a few items and are not subject to the demands of changing clothing styles.
 - Students who attend the school are readily recognizable which reinforces school identity, a sense of community, school pride, and school security.

Uniform Requirements for Students in Grades 1 – 12

1. All articles of the school uniform must be in a good state of repair and must be of a size to fit the wearer. Clothing must be free of gross wrinkles, food spots, dirt and grass stains, and fraying. Shoes shall be clean and with soles in a good state of repair.
2. All articles of clothing should be clearly labeled in permanent ink with the name of the owner.
3. **Students should be dressed in their school uniform, properly tied, tucked, buttoned, etc. whenever they are on the school premises, unless they are in athletic attire for an after school activity. In particular it should be noted that blazers (or the optional sweaters for students in grades 1-8) must be worn at all times on Wednesday unless students are given express permission to remove them during class, at lunchtime, or at other times when it may be deemed appropriate. If students wish to change clothing to attend athletic activities after school, they are to follow the Non-Uniform Guidelines. Students attending school functions are to be dressed appropriately, following the Non-Uniform Guidelines.**
4. No athletic clothing is to be worn during the school day unless given permission by the Head of School. Students are given time to change into athletic clothing before departing on school buses for games.
5. a) Jewelry for girls must be modest: gold and silver with small pearls or gemstones. One earring may be worn in each ear and worn in the ear lobe only. Girls in grades 1 – 3 may wear pierced earring studs only. Girls in grades 4 – 12 may wear earrings with a modest 1½ - 2” dangle. Girls in all grades may wear simple, unadorned headbands (i.e. no flowers, feathers, etc.). Scarves—on heads or around necks— are not allowed for girls in any grade.

b) Boys may not wear earrings or studs. No ankle bracelets or other ankle/leg bracelets or choker- style necklaces may be worn.
6. Tattoos, temporary or permanent, are not acceptable with the exception of WCDS temporary tattoos or markings during Spirit Week or Field Day.
7. Hair must be of the student’s natural color. Boys’ and girls’ hairstyles must be conservative. Shaved is not acceptable.
8. Boys must be clean-shaven daily. Hair must be neatly trimmed, clean, out of the eyes in the front, and off the collar in the back. Sideburns shall not extend below the ear lobe.
9. Hats and caps shall not be worn in the school buildings or at formal school functions. Hats and caps are allowed, however, when they are part of a designated “spirit” activity. An exception is also granted during cold weather, when headgear designed to keep the head warm may be worn to and from school.
10. Athletic shoes, hiking boots, canvas shoes, cowboy boots, or flip flops are not authorized for wear with the boys’ or girls’ school uniform at any time. Leather, oxford-style shoes, loafers, or flats will be the only type of shoe authorized for wear with the school uniform. No sling back, open-toed shoes, open-heel shoes, or shoes with a heel/sole combination higher than 1½” are allowed. Shoes should be of a plain, dark color appropriate to the school uniform.
11. An unadorned, dress leather belt must be worn with all pants and skirts fitted with belt loops.

12. Sunglasses may not be worn during class in the school building.
13. T-shirts, undershirts, and/or bras with designs may not be visible beneath blouses or shirts.
14. No baggy, flared-leg, hip-hugger, bell-bottom, Levi-cut jeans, skin tight yoga pants, cargo pocket pants or cargo shorts are to be worn in place of dress slacks.

Pockets on both boys' and girls' slacks/trousers must be slash pockets. Pants with patch pockets are NOT permitted. A slash pocket is entered through a slash on the outside of the garment and has a pouch attached inside the garment. A patch pocket is attached to the outside of the garment, like a shirt pocket.

15. Upon arriving at school, students must place all coats, jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies, nylon windbreakers, hats, scarves, gloves, etc. in their lockers. Aside from Wakefield-approved blazers, sweaters, and fleece vests with the school crest, no outerwear may be worn during class in the building without the express permission of the Head of School.
14. All students wear the Dress Uniform on Wednesdays and on school field trips and athletic/sports team trips. The Head of School is the only person who can exempt students from wearing the Dress Uniform. This exemption is sometimes granted when the weather is very warm or when other circumstances render the Dress Uniform inappropriate.

NON-UNIFORM GUIDELINES

On the last school day of each month, the Head of School may grant a Non-Uniform Day to the entire school providing the students have not received too many uniform demerits in the given month. Sometimes, in recognition of a sports event or a national academic honor, the Head of School may grant a Non-Uniform Red & White Day to a specific class. The spirit of the Non-Uniform code assumes that 1) students will avoid extreme modes of dress and will appear at school in clothing that is clean and in a good state of repair; and 2) all students will be prepared for academic study. The Non-Uniform Dress should not distract anyone from his or her task of learning.

The following guidelines are to be observed on these non-uniform school days as well as on school grounds outside the regular school day:

- 1) Dress slacks or any slacks that are neat and of a modest cut, loose-fitting without being oversized (i.e. baggy, hem dragging on the floor) are permitted.
- 2) Blue jeans (free of rips, tears and holes) are permitted, with all the caveats stated above in the case of slacks.
- 3) Shorts are permitted, when appropriate to the weather, providing that they are of a modest cut and loose fit, and are not more than 4" above the knee in length.
- 4) WCDS athletic shorts are permitted but only if they are not too short or too tight. The current volleyball team shorts are not acceptable.
- 5) Skirts are to be of a modest cut and no more than 2" above the knee. Blue denim skirts are permitted.
- 6) All pants, shorts, and skirts must be in good repair, hemmed, and without holes and tears.

- 7) Only the top button on a button down shirt should be unbuttoned.
- 8) Tee-shirts and sweatshirts are to be of a plain, solid color and may not bear messages or slogans except with pictures or emblems bearing the name of a college or university, a geographic location, an educational organization like the Smithsonian, or an athletic team.
- 9) Tee-shirts and sweatshirts earned or bought at academic conventions or competitions (such as JCL National or State conventions) are also acceptable.
- 10) No tank tops, no clothing with “spaghetti straps,” no tight or revealing blouses or t-shirts and no yoga or tight fitting pants are to be worn.
- 11) Partial school uniforms are not to be worn. When a student is wearing the school uniform, it must be complete, properly tied, tucked, buttoned, etc.
- 12) Field trip décor will depend on the activities inherent to the field trip. Dress Uniforms are required for trips to the city for concerts, plays, museums, lectures, university visits, etc. Non-Uniform attire as described above is acceptable for trips to locations which require more hands on community service or to amusement parks like Kings Dominion. Periodically outdoor attire requiring water proof boots or outerwear is accepted per direction of an individual teacher planning the field trip. During exams, girls and boys are allowed to wear navy or evergreen polo shirts and navy or khaki pants.

Students who find themselves unable to comply with the spirit of these rules will be required to change their clothing or wear school-provided clothing.
